ImmsBC Vaccine Management Digital Platform



Citizen Registration, Notifications & Reminders

- Multi-Channel Registration (On-line, Phone, Walk-in)
- 140 languages supported through a contact centre translation service
- Low barrier "expression of interest" and notification to book appointment
- Reminders to book



Provincial Call Centre Appointment Booking

- Multi-Channel appointment booking (On-line, Phone, Walk-in)
- 140 languages supported through a contact centre translation service
- Solution enables the loading and management of clinic locations, hours and appointment schedules
- Solution "builds" the mass imms event clinic list
- Appointment reminders



Inventory Supply Console

Enables tracking of inventory including:

- Loading and management of vaccine inventory
- Transfers
- Received
- Wastage



Clinician Experience

Enables the clinic workflow and streamlined citizen experience including:


- Loading and management of vaccine inventory
- Appointment checkin validation of client identity
- Vaccine administration
- In alignment with clinical documentation standards



Reporting & Analytics

Supports Federal, Provincial and Health Authority Reporting for each component, for example:

- Clinic Operations
- Inventory management
- · Daily doses administered
- Integrates with Pharmanet
 To support billing processes







Register and book with the Get Vaccinated system

You can register yourself or someone else, like a parent, grandparent or child. We will never ask you for your SIN, driver's licence number or t and credit card details.

Once you've registered, you'll be able to book an appointment using your confirmation number. Booking an appointment online or by phone convenient and guarantees your vaccination at a community pharmacy or vaccination clinic near you.

If needed, you can easily reschedule your appointment online.

Fastest option: Online

To register online, you must provide:

- First and last name
- Date of birth
- Postal code
- Personal Health Number (PHN)
- An email address that gets checked regularly or a phone number that can receive text messages

Find your PHN on the back of your B.C. driver's licence, BC Services Card or CareCard.

Other registration and booking options

By phone - Pick this option if you don't have a PHN

At a Service BC office

Everyone can get vaccinated, even if you don't have a PHN or documentation.

It doesn't matter if you are a Canadian citizen or not. Register even if you have already received dose 1 in another location. All of your information will be kept private and will never be shared with other agencies or parts of government.





Vaccine Inventory Management



Established in PIR










• Immunization records for all ages (child primary series vaccines, school aged vaccines, adults, influenza, COVID-19) from early 1990s to present



• Due and Overdue forecasts for all vaccines across ages 0-19





• Special populations (Clinical Extremely Vulnerable, immunocompromised, whole communities)



• Clinical practice standards; documentation standards; clinical record review

- Client identification management
- Connection to CareConnect and Health Gateway



How PIR Supported BC COVID-19 Response


- Initial dose gated based on age, community etc.
- Subsequent doses relied on forecast
- eForm for Indigenous communities to submit COVID-19 immunizations
- Ability to use population denominator, addresses (for community prioritization), self-identity Indigenous, high risk clients, CEV risk factors
- Only time all RHAs using one system to manage vaccine inventory
- Enabled at the minute reporting for leadership to make decisions on eligibility, clinic capacity based on vaccine availability, clinic management, vaccine waste management, cold chain incidents
- Fraudulent record investigations through Record Submission Portal



Data Flows to ImmsBC

- Daily feed of COVID-19 vaccine history and forecast to ImmsBC
- On-demand pull of COVID-19 forecast from PIR to ImmsBC
- Daily feed of AEFI, COVID-19 risk factors, alerts to ImmsBC
- Updated demographics, client identity data from EMPI distribution updates
- Push of vaccine inventory catalogue data changes to ImmsBC

Forecasting COVID-19 Immunizations



Timeline of Tools Developed for COVID Imms

eForms

December 2020

Enabled a unified provincial response from the start of the campaign

Set the stage for the data-driven BC program

Maintained for First Nations throughout campaign

ImmsBC

March/April 2021

Fulsome system enabling registration, booking, notifications, clinical record review and documentation

Interfaced with Provincial Immunization Registry to enable provincial and federal proof of vaccinations

Vaccine inventory module enabled at-the-minute reporting

Record Submission
Portal

July 2021

Enabled the public to submit COVID records from doses received in other provinces or countries to provide provincial and federal proof of vaccinations

~400K submitted by Nov 2022

Reviewed and validated by PPHIS team

Identified patterns of potential fraudulent records for further investigation








Managing Access to ImmsBC

- Up to **25,000** accounts granted access between April 2021 – Oct 2022
- Delegated Access Management to Health Authorities and BC Pharmacy Association
- Multi Factor Authorization enforces
- Automated Salesforce Account Provisioning and De-**Provisioning**
- Role level access for:
 - **Service Agents** (TELUS and Service BC)
 - **Clerks** (Check-in and document Imms)
 - Clinicians (Access to clinical conditions, collect consent and document immunization)
 - Imms Admin (Manage Schedule and Inventory)
 - **BCCDC Admin** (Data Quality and Inventory supply)
- Full Audit and Access logging
- Multi layer Access threat detection automated account lockout
